

1. Were you there yesterday? (with “в” nouns)

Go through the list, asking your partner if they were “in” these places yesterday. All nouns take **-e** unless otherwise noted!

— Ты был(а) **в библиотеке** вчера? Were you **in the library** yesterday?
 — Да, был(а). / Нет, не был(а). Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't.

2. Were you there yesterday? (with “на” nouns)

Now try some nouns that we're “on” in Russian... Many of these spaces are flat, open surfaces, but a few may be unexpected.

— Ты был(а) **на пляже** вчера? Were you **at the beach** yesterday?
 — Да, был(а). / Нет, не был(а). Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't.

мост (-у!) bridge	берег (-у!) shore	остров island
вокзал train station	тротуар sidewalk	пляж beach
эскалатор escalator	поезд train	улица street
пол (-у!) floor	стадион stadium	дача dacha

3. Remember: all “events” are “на” nouns)

Now ask about events... Remembering that we are always “on” events and gatherings in Russian — including classes, lectures, etc.

— Ты был(а) **на концерте** вчера? Were you **at a concert** yesterday?
 — Да, был(а). / Нет, не был(а). Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't.

4. Where will you be tomorrow?

Now sum things up by asking about everywhere your partner expects to be tomorrow.

— Где ты будешь завтра? Where will you be tomorrow?
