Day 35

1. Were you in the library yesterday?

There are two simple ways to ask where people have been. The first asks, literally, "Where they were..." (using rae expressions).

— Ты был(<u>а</u>) в библиот<u>е</u>ке вчер <u>а</u> ?	Were you in the library yesterday?
— Ты был(<u>а</u>) на конц<u>е</u>рте на пр <u>о</u> шлой нед <u>е</u> ле?	Were you at a concert last week?
— Ты был(<u>а</u>) на вечер<u>и</u>нке в пр <u>о</u> шлые выходн <u>ы</u> е?	Were you at a party last weekend?
— Ты б <u>у</u> дешь на л<u>е</u>кции з <u>а</u> втра?	Will you be at the lecture tomorrow?
— Ты б <u>удешь на уроке русского языка в суббо</u> ту?	Will you be at Russian class on Saturday?
— Ты был(<u>а</u>) в Росс<u>и</u>и в пр <u>о</u> шлом год <u>у</u> ?	Were you in Russia last year?
— Ты б <u>у</u> дешь в Росс<u>и</u>и в <u>э</u> том год <u>у</u> ?	Will you be in Russia this year?

2. Where did you go yesterday

A second way of asking the same thing asks "To where they went..." (using куда expressions). We'll learn about these verbs tomorrow.

— Ты ход <u>и</u> л(а) на спект<u>а</u>кль вчер <u>а</u> ?	Did you go to a performance yesterday?
— Ты ход <u>и</u> л(а) на зан<u>я</u>тие вчер <u>а</u> ?	Did you go to class yesterday?
— Ты ход <u>и</u> л(а) в спортз<u>а</u>л в пр <u>о</u> шлом м <u>е</u> сяце?	Did you go to the gym last month?
— Ты ход <u>и</u> л(а) на тренир<u>о</u>вку вчер <u>а</u> ?	Did you go to (sports) practice yesterday?
— Ты ход <u>и</u> л(а) на репет<u>и</u>цию вчер <u>а</u> ?	Did you go to a rehearsal yesterday?
— Ты ход <u>и</u> л(а) на хор<u>о</u>шую в <u>ы</u> ставку в посл <u>ед</u> нее вр <u>е</u> мя?	Have you been to a good exhibit lately?
— Ты <u>е</u> здил(а) в Нью-Йорк в посл <u>е</u> днее вр <u>е</u> мя?	Have you been to New York lately?

3. Are you going to the party tomorrow?

Here, the verb changes. More on this tomorrow; for now, answer using "иду" for the first three, and "еду" for the final example.

— Ты ид <u>ё</u> шь на спект<u>а</u>кль з <u>а</u> втра?	Are you going to a performance tomorrow?
— Ты ид <u>ё</u> шь в стол<u>о</u>вую на <u>у</u>жин сег <u>о</u> дня?	Are you going to the dining hall for dinner today?
— Ты ид <u>ё</u> шь дом<u>о</u>й в общеж<u>и</u>тие сег <u>о</u> дня в <u>е</u> чером?	Are you going home to the dorm tonight?
— Ты <u>е</u> дешь в Москву или в Петербург в <u>э</u> том году?	Are you going to Moscow or P-burg this year?

4. Questions

Review by answering these questions. Note that the first two are really two ways of asking the same thing. Note the question words!

— Где ты был(<u>а</u>) вчер <u>а</u> ?	Where were you yesterday?
— Куда ты ход <u>и</u> л(а) вчер <u>а</u> ?	Where did you go yesterday?
— Куда ты <u>е</u> здил(а) в пр <u>о</u> шлом год <u>у</u> ?	Where did you go (travel) last year?
— Куда ты ид <u>ё</u> шь сегодня?	Where are you going today?
— Куда ты <u>е</u> дешь <u>э</u> тим л <u>е</u> том?	Where are you going this summer?
