2. His, hers, theirs

IMPORTANT: The third-person possessives (**ero**, **eë**, **ux** — his, hers, theirs) are identical with the accusative pronoun forms (**ero**, **eë**, **ux** — him, her, them). To avoid confusion down the road, try to remember: when (**ero**, **eë**, **ux**) mean (his hers, theirs) — that is, when they express **possession**, they will **NEVER CHANGE THEIR FORM**, under any circumstance whatsoever!

ALSO: remember that **ero** is pronounced as if written **eвo**. We'll see this same combination of letters in other words, like **сегодня** (today), or **y него** (at him) — there too, the **ero** is pronounced **eво**. Watch for this, and you'll quickly get used to it.
